

ACTS ODYSSEY: Discussion Questions

Week 6: Corinth

Small group rules to keep in mind:

In your sharing time be as open and transparent as you comfortably feel you can. There is no need to challenge, correct, or give advice unless asked for. Be careful to not in “over share”. Be sensitive to give everyone an opportunity to join in.

For each week, start off your discussions with the first two questions. After that choose any of the other questions which you feel best suits your particular group.

1. What insight spoke to you most in the video study today?
2. Open your book. Take turns sharing one major insight you received from the reading this week. Take time for other members to turn to each passage being highlighted.
3. In this story, Paul’s freedom to preach is affirmed by a surprising source... the pagan Roman governor. How have you seen God work through non-believers or secular authorities to advance the gospel? How did that encourage you?
4. In verse eight of our text tonight, God let Paul know through a vision that He has prepared many people in Corinth to receive Christ. Do you feel God is at work in our community as He was in Corinth in Paul’s day? In what ways have you seen God working in Maui and in our community to set people free?
5. No doubt Priscilla and Aquila were a tremendous encouragement and support to Paul and his ministry. Who in your life needs you to come alongside them for a season to support and to encourage them? In what practical ways do you feel you could help?

Prayer for the journey: “Lord God, help me to make my primary goal in life to testify to the good news of your grace. May I be one who preserves relationships by showing respect to those who disagree with me. I especially call upon Your help to love anyone who would try to intimidate or hassle me. in Jesus name I pray, AMEN.”
