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3. What is Paul's main point in 1 Thessalonians 2? How does this picture of Christianity differ with today's version?
4. What does 1 Thessalonians 2 teach us about the character/nature of God?

### **TAKING IT HOME**

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5. We learned during the message that every believer is a minister and entrusted with the Gospel. What areas of your life are the easiest to be bold in faith and minister hope to others? What areas are the most difficult and why? (i.e. *work, family, church, neighborhood, hobbies, etc*)
6. Our culture and society more and more pushes against the truth of the Gospel of Jesus and against morality and the truth of the Bible. What habits do you have in your life to know God's Word and to trust God's Word when you feel the pressure of culture?
7. Paul was willing to be inconvenienced, uncomfortable, and lay down his rights in order to love and share the gospel with others. How do you stay motivated to stay on God's mission, even when it's hard?
8. Kyle asked in the message, "Do you spend more time worried about what people think of me, or more time asking what it means to be faithful to Jesus?"
