1. In the message from this weekend or the video, what encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why? What applications for your life did you learn?
2. From this weeks Scripture, what encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why?

A Deeper Look

4. What is the significance of Jesus' "I am" statements: "I am the door" (v. 9), and "I am the Good Shepherd" (v. 14)? What impact do each of these truths hold for your life personally?
5. Read vs 9. What comforts you & what implications does this verse have on your life?
(i.e. security, peace, need to share Jesus with others, rest, love, etc)

TAKING IT HOME

6. In which area(s) of your life is it difficult for you to trust Jesus as the Good Shepherd? How can you strive to trust that He knows best, and to follow His voice/His leading?
7. Jesus says, his sheep know His voice. Who or what has the biggest say/influence in your life, Jesus who is Lord and came to give abundant life? Or Is His voice drowned out by the noise (news, culture, entertainment, politics, etc) of this world?

What things could help you personally to know, listen and obey Jesus voice more?
8. Read Psalm 23. What truths of from this passage do you personally need to be reminded of and why?

Spend some time during this series reading the Gospels—Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
