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**'OHANA GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS**

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(SERIES: "CLUES: HOW CAN WE KNOW WE KNOW" WEEK 4: PSALM 139:13-16, EPHESIANS 2:10, GENESIS 1:26-27, ACTS 14:15, "ORIGIN")

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1. In the message from this weekend or the video, what encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why? What applications for your life did you learn?
2. From this week's Scripture, what encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why?
3. Open your book. Take turns sharing one major insight you received from any part of this week's reading. Take time for other members to turn to each passage being highlighted.

**A DEEPER LOOK**

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4. Read Psalm 139:13-16 & Ephesians 2:10. Then read the last paragraph on pg 68-69. Have you ever stopped to consider that God *created* you and you are His masterpiece? Share how that affects how you see yourself and the world around you.
5. Now read Genesis 1:26-27. How and why does the reality that you were Created give you personal meaning and purpose for life?
6. On pg. 68 Danny writes in the third paragraph, "However you can't get to heaven without Jesus. In most of my witnessing, I have found it more fruitful to direct the conversation back to Jesus. He is the important thing." Why is this important? What are some practical ways you can steer conversations back to Jesus rather than debates on various other topics? Go around and share.
