ROMANS 1:1-17

1. What from the message this weekend encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why? What applications for your life did you learn?
2. From this week's Scripture, what encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why?

A DEEPER LOOK

3. In what areas of your life do you need to grow toward and focus on grace? For yourself and others?
4. Kyle mentioned that Paul sees the gospel as an obligation (v14), is eager to share it (v15), and is unashamed of the good news (v16). Which of these 3 do you think you could grow in when it comes to looking at the gospel?

TAKING IT HOME

5. Verses 9 and 10 mention that Paul constantly mentioned Rome in his prayers. How can you implement prayer practices for others in your own life?
6. Kyle also mentioned that we often downplay the power of prayer and come to it as a last resort. How can we look at prayer differently and show those around us how important prayer is?
7. Verse 12 mentions that Paul wanted to go visit Rome so that he would experience mutual encouragement through faith with the believers in Rome. Do you find yourself being mutually encouraged by other believers? How can you do this in your regular life?
