3. Why is *earning* such a big value in our culture? Can you give examples? How is this different from what is true of the Gospel? Why is that good news?
4. Why is this statement so important: "Salvation is by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone"?

### **TAKING IT HOME**

5. If living by faith is a receiving and resting in Christ, why can it be so hard to continually rest in Christ? How can you continually remind yourself to rest in Christ?
6. Verse 18 says that in hope Abraham believed against hope. What does this mean and how can this encourage you?
7. Verse 20 says that Abraham did not waver in unbelief at God's promise but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God. In what places in your life do you need to be praying "I believe but help my unbelief" (Mark 9:24)?
