ROMANS 3:27-31

1. What from the message this weekend encouraged you, challenged you, or spoke to you most, and why? What applications for your life did you learn?
2. From this week's Scripture, what encouraged you, challenged you, or spoke to you most and why?

A DEEPER LOOK

3. Humility should be a defining aspect of the Christian life. Consider some of our culture's barriers to humility and how Christians or churches might foster gospel-driven humility. (verse 27).
4. How can we apply the Old Testament to our lives today? What can we learn from the Old Testament? (verse 31)
5. Think through the Ten Commandments and various lists of sins (Rom. 1:29-31; Gal. 5:19-21; 1 Tim. 1:9-10). How is pride at the root of all of these sins? (verse 31)

TAKING IT HOME

6. What do we boast in: self or God? How should this change the way we share our testimony? (verse 27)
7. God has been the God of all nations and God's people have been on mission for all nations. How should this inform our life and ministry as a local church? (verse 29)
