'OHANA GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS

WEEK 3: "TRUE LIFE" - JOHN 2:1-22

1. What from the message this weekend encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why? What applications for your life did you learn?
2. From this week's Scripture, what encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why?

A DEEPER LOOK

3. This is the first of seven signs that John records. We know that there are other signs and miracles that Jesus performs (some recorded in the other gospels). Why do you think John is selective in the signs that he records? (See John 21:25)
4. When Jesus turns the water into wine, the master of the banquet points out the difference in the quality of the wine. This new wine points to Jesus' blood that purifies us and the new covenant that he makes available to us. Discuss the differences between the old and new covenant.
5. What connection do you think these two stories have (Jesus turning water to wine and clearing the temple)? Or does it just seem out of place to you?
