## **'OHANA GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS**

WEEK 2: "TRUE LIFE" - JOHN 1:19-51

### **Small group rules to keep in mind:**

In your sharing time be as open and transparent as you comfortably feel you can. There is no need to challenge, correct, or give advice unless asked for. Be careful to not "over share". Be sensitive to give everyone an opportunity to join in. For each week, start off your discussions with the first two questions. After that, choose any of the other questions which you feel best suits your particular group.

1. What from the message this weekend encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why? What applications for your life did you learn?
2. From this week's Scripture, what encouraged you, challenged you or spoke to you most and why?

### **A DEEPER LOOK**

3. Read John 1:29. What truths about Jesus' mission can we learn from this verse? Jesus' mission and love is clear from the beginning, He came to give His life to pay the penalty for your sin and remove it all together. How does this truth personally encourage you?
4. Read John 1:39. Jesus called his first followers come and see. How has your personal faith grown over time as you've come to see Jesus & all His love?
5. Jesus calls us to fully follow & trust Him. What areas do you need God to help you follow Jesus in? (i.e. finances, Morals, prayer, loving others, trusting, etc)

### **TAKING IT HOME**

6. Jesus' disciples invited others to come & see Jesus to believe. How can you bring or help others see Jesus & His love this week? Year?
7. Read John 1:47-49. Jesus sees you. He knows about your struggles and He sees the pain you may carry around. How does it personally comfort you that Jesus sees & knows you?
