3. How does Psalm 8 add to your understanding of Hebrews 2:5-18? What similarities do you notice about these passages?
4. Hebrews 2:11 states, "For he who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one source." What does this mean? What is sanctification?

TAKING IT HOME

5. How does knowing that Jesus is not ashamed of us (and that He considers us to be His brothers and sisters) change the way you view yourself and others?
6. What is the motivation behind your actions and decisions in life? Is it the fear of death? Or is it the Gospel?
7. How does this passage encourage you to live with an eternal mindset?
